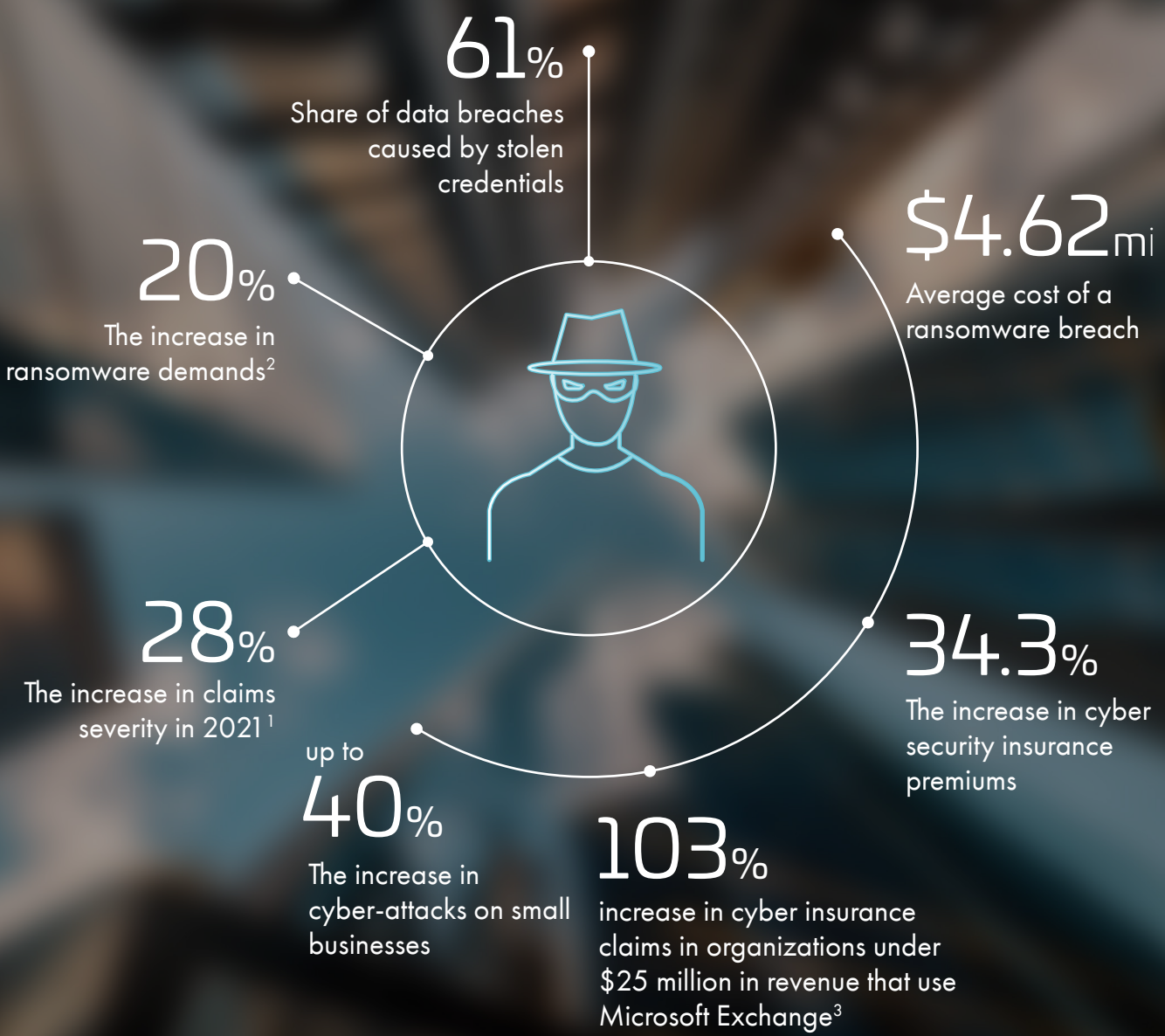


Multi-factor Authentication
